We need to provide the university with the final list of students joining each of the courses below as soon as possible. Hence, students who wish to contribute and be committed to any of the following courses must register their names, mobile no, email and valid passport number by Thursday 2nd March 2017 at the secretary office of The Electronics and Communications Engineering Dept.

The financial details will be announced in a form of a package (Euros + Egyptian Pounds) at a later time. The exact amounts will depend on the following factors:

- Tuition fees
- Accommodation
- Air fare
- Visa fees
- Administrative fees
- Total number of students registering in each program.

The training will be conducted at the School of Engineering where the following courses will be offered if at least 10 students are registered in each of them:

COURSE 1: Power electronics for renewable energy systems and electrical vehicles. Ideally, students with some interest and foundations in Electronics and Electrical Engineering should be selected.

COURSE 2: Machine Vision and Robotics and Multimedia Security. Ideally, we should try to recruit students with some knowledge about Computer Engineering.

COURSE 3: The aim of this course is to introduce the students into the design of embedded systems: microprocessor-based systems with some associated hardware (wired or reconfigurable) and possibly with real-time computer constraints.

Courses cannot be mixed, since the contents in both groups are very different and there is no time in just 3 weeks to go in depth for each student in both courses. Therefore, each one of our students should select only one of the courses.
